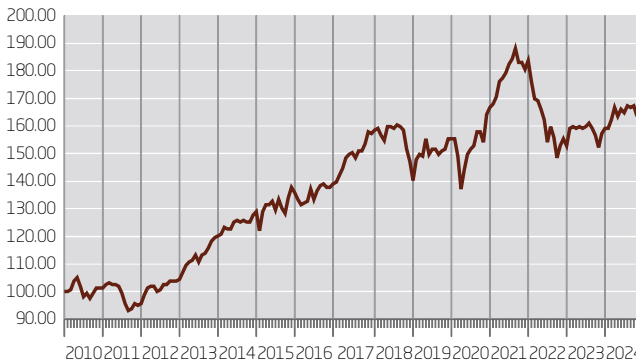
Investment Horizon

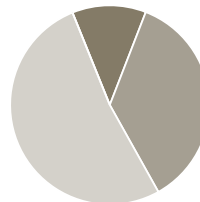

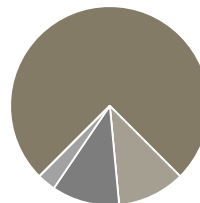
