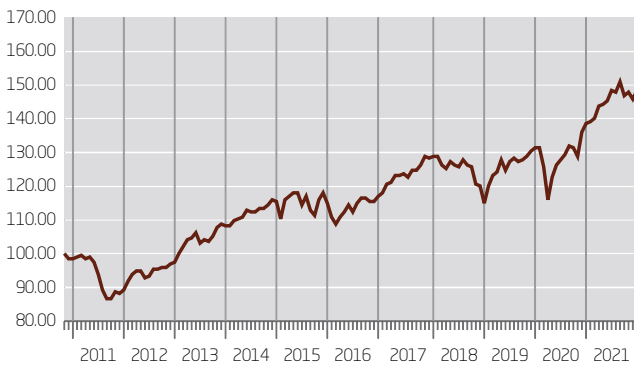
### Investment Horizon

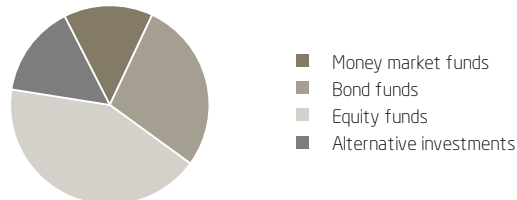

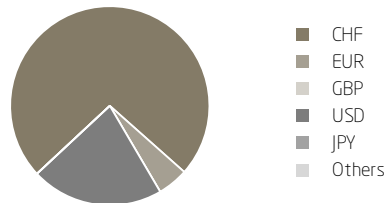
