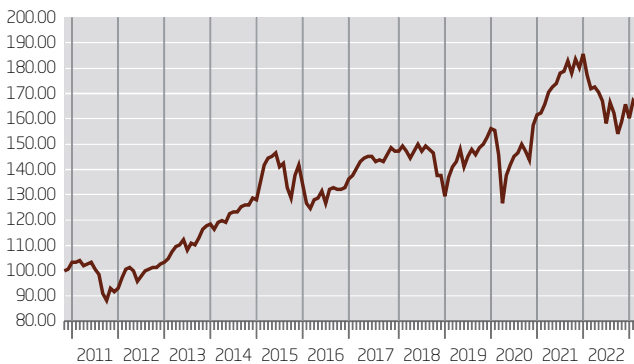
Investment Horizon

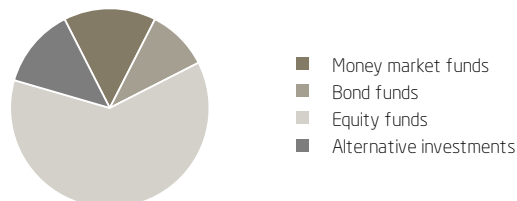

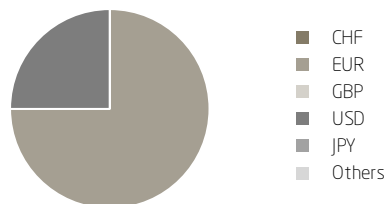
